
- A one-stop destination for committee members to contact, thank, and solicit prospects

Dashboard:


- Located at the top of the page, the Dashboard section allows you to monitor your progress as you work through your list.

My Prospects:


- List of the prospects that have been assigned to you.

Contacting your Prospects:


- Click on the method of contact Letter/Email,
